These expectations apply to all school settings including excursions and bus lines/ travel.

	Behaviours
<p>Yellow behaviour: Teacher to manage <i>Prompt – redirect – reteach</i> reminder of expectations. In the playground student walks with the teacher. Not entered into Sentral.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Careless use of property • Unintentional physical contact • Lack of respect in manner • Slow to comply with requests • Isolated name calling out and put downs • Yelling or loitering in toilets
<p>Orange behaviour:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time out in classroom/playground • Teacher and student conference to discuss behaviour and behaviour expectations 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Breakage of property through reckless misuse • Pushing/shoving • Grabbing at body or clothes • Rough Play • Challenging defiant manner/ non-compliant/refusal • swearing • Consistent refusing of request • Repeated put downs and name calling/ repeated refusal to comply • Playing in toilet • Leaving classroom without permission
<p>Red behaviour:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sent to buddy class to fill out reflection sheet • Teacher to enter into Sentral with student. • If 3 incidents within 2 weeks (sent to buddy class) will result with parents being notified and Reflection Room. • If incident happens in the playground, student sent straight to the principal <p>Letter home noting number of incidents. Reflection room, may result in suspension. Staff to enter on Sentral, CC Principal.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Destructive use of property • Striking, punching, pushing, kicking or any other intentional contact including throwing objects • Verbally aggressive e.g name calling/put down • Theft of others equipment • Consistently non-compliant • Continual disobedience • Threatening harm • Invading privacy • Urinating in inappropriate areas/ways • Dangerous behaviour in toilets • Swearing at another person • Bullying/cyber bullying

**Self-defence means to protect one's body or retreat- Retaliation is NOT self-defence*

**** Teacher discretion will be applied to every incident and all situations will be handled in context.**

Reflection Room

- To be held second half of lunch in a classroom.
- If students don't turn up they automatically get an extra day
- Teachers responsibility to add and date students' name in the folder and put it on Sentral
- Student can only attend if all paper work is completed beforehand
- 3 x student is sent to buddy class over 2 weeks = 1 reflection room and letter sent home
- 3 x sent to reflection room over a 2 week period = behaviour card for a week and child is to report to the principal every day for it to be signed, warning letter of suspension
- If student is on a behaviour card – all leadership responsibilities are put on hold and badge kept during this time e.g SRC, Sports leader
- Mentor program for at risk children where they can choose a teacher of choice and 'check-in' with them every morning and end of recess. To be discussed with the principal.

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
