
Jolly Phonics Program

Students will need their whiteboard, texta and eraser OR a piece of paper and a pencil.

Instructions:

- 1. Introduce letter name and sound
- 2. Sing the Jolly Phonics song and learn the action. This can be found on youtube.
- 3. Find the letter on the yellow butterfly card
- 4. Model how to write the letter of the day
- 5. Students write the letter multiple times on their whiteboards
- 6. Model how to write the sight word of the day
 Stretch it out to hear the sounds before writing it down
- 7. Students write the word multiple times on their whiteboards
- 8. Students sound out the focus word during the writing process. They focus on looking at the letters and their corresponding sounds that make up the word.
- 9. Modelled sentence- Explain to students that they will now be writing a sentence using the sight word, focus letter and their butterfly cards.
 - Model writing a sentence; Use a capital letter, spaces between each word and a full stop at the end. Focus on sounding out words (does not have to be spelt correctly), as well as, rereading the sentence to check that it looks right and makes sense. Focus on writing from left to right. There are special hand actions for the following verbal cues:
 - We write from this side to that side
 - We always start with a capital letter
 - Before we start a new word we need to leave a space
 - We need to re-read our work to check that it looks right and makes sense
 - We finish with a full stop. This tells us that the sentence is done.
- 10. Students copy the modelled sentence as the teacher writes it
- 11. Students then check and mark each other's work. Students provide feedback to each other. One thing that their peer did well and one thing for them to work on. Examples could include letter formations, neat handwriting, spaces, capital letter, full stop etc.
- 12. Every Friday will be a revision day for ALL of the letters/sounds learnt throughout the week.
