Remembrance Day

This week on Thursday 11th a small ceremony will be held at 11:00AM to commemorate Remembrance Day. Later the same day we will hold a small ceremony with Lyall Dalton who has donated a Lone Pine to the school. We will plant the Lone Pine to commemorate the battle in 1915 where the Lone Pine or Plateau 400 was the scene of a major diversionary offensive launched by the 1st Australian Infantry Division. The Turks had cut down all but one of the trees that clothed the ridge to cover their trenches. The ridge dominated by the single Allepo Pine (Pinus halepensis) became known as Lone Pine. In three days of fighting the Australians lost more than 2,000 men and the Turks loses were estimated at 7.000. Seven Victoria Crosses were awarded. As far as we know two Australian soldiers souvenired pinecones from the ridge that found their way back to Australia.


